Theory Programs

Theory course topics: Introduction to crane certification process; safety fundamentals for crane operators; crane operation knowledge; rigging knowledge; crane rigging charts; communications knowledge; load chart knowledge; crane service and maintenance and crane set-up and pre-trip inspections.

Practical Programs

The practical training section of the crane training school emphasizes hands-on learning. This portion of the course focuses on the identification and terminology of crane components. Trainees would have the chance to perform skills needed for crane signaling, rigging and operating.

The topics covered in the practical part consists of: Learn crane terminology; identify crane components and functions; use remote control; identify wire ropes and rigging; pre-use inspection on crane; identify documents and regulations for rigging and wire rope; carry out rigging methods; utilize radio and hand signals; and perform correct lowering and lifting of loads.
