Telehandler Training Courses Prince Albert - Employers are responsible for making sure that their operating personnel and supervisors are trained to work competently utilizing telehandler machines. The skill level of staff must be assessed. If deficiencies are found, employers should provide training so that staff attain the required level of ability. The level of responsibility of the individual must be considered when training is offered. Effective training will solve whatever deficiencies in the knowledge, skills and understanding of telehandler supervisors and operators. Training can be undertaken through in-house session or by engaging the services of an external training provider. An assessment at the completion of the training period will determine if the learning objectives have been met or not.

Regulations and guidelines for the basic telehandler operator training and testing are set by state/provincial, local and federal regulators. Basic training does not deal with such topics as the lifting of suspended loads, the lifting of persons, the operation of rotating equipment or the use of other attachments. Further training would need to be undertaken if such tasks are needed on the work place.

Inspection and maintenance

Like whichever machinery, a telehandler needs effective maintenance. The machine inevitably will suffer wear sooner or later. Right maintenance is important to ensuring safe operation of the telehandler machine. Checks and inspections are essential to ongoing maintenance measures. Operators need to have machine-specific training in order to monitor, prevent and rectify problems connected with wear, deterioration and damage. Workers require experience and competence in both periodic and breakdown maintenance. The preventive maintenance directions of the manufacturer should be viewed seriously and complied with, considering such factors as environmental conditions in the work setting and frequency of use.

The user of the machinery along with the owner of the machine share the responsibility for making certain that the telehandler is in full working condition. Pre-use inspections are usually carried out by the user, whereas general maintenance is normally carried out by the telehandler owner.
