Counterbalance Forklift Training Prince Albert - Demand is always high for our popular Counterbalance Forklift Truck Training courses. A Counterbalance forklift refers to a forklift along with a weight that counters the balance, allowing the load's weight to be distributed evenly across the forklift arms. Counterbalance forklifts are made so the weight behind the center of gravity is counterbalanced by the weight on the lift. The load is projected out from the machine's front so it is visible to the forklift driver. This particular type of forklift truck should only be used on stable, level ground or on a prepared surface.

Forklift operators are required to receive training which will allow them to better know the right or proper method across the forklift arms. The trainee will be taught to properly raise and lower the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the lift truck, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both forwards and backwards. Individuals training would learn the RTITB standards required for safe forklift operation. Trainees will likewise become familiar with the types of attachments for the arms of the forklift.

Types of Counterbalance Forklifts:

Walkie Pallet Trucks

Walkie Pallet Truck is a counterbalance forklift suitable for getting into areas which are small and cramped. This particular lift is highly maneuverable and could access almost whatever tight spot.

Walkie Stackers

The Walkie Stacker differs from the Walkie Pallet truck mainly when it comes to lift height. The Walkie Stacker could access tight places and has extra lift for high stacking capability. Neither of the Walkie line of lifts could be ridden. The driver has to walk behind them.

Rider Pallet Trucks

The Rider Pallet Truck is made so the driver can ride it. These riding lifts are perfect for dock loading and unloading.
